- Champion the standardization and simplification of design, minimizing the custom solutions only for cases where Novartis makes a difference in the market serving customers/patients.
- Prepare and run design workshops, identify critical integration points and dependencies, propose solutions for key gaps, provide effort estimations while ensuring alignment with business and IT teams.
- Assure consistency and traceability between user requirements, functional specifications, architectural roadmaps, regulatory/control requirements, and smooth transition of solutions to operations
- Deliver assigned work as per agreed program timelines adhering to the release calendar.
